CAGLIARI/BLACK SEA

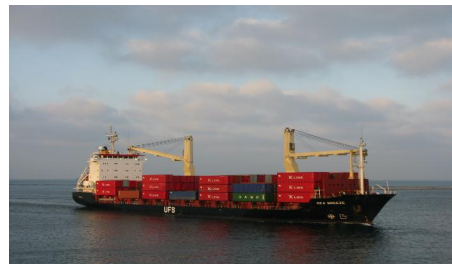
GREEK PORTS ADDED

PORT SITUATION

DAMIETTA

As per Container Terminal regulations, we are forced to provide our loading instructions 24 hours prior feeder vessel's arrival at Damietta and no changes are

IZMIR

Port is currently congested. Yard low productivity due to lack of land equipment.

Average delays 1 day.

BEIRUT

Port is currently congested due to heavy traffic. yard low productivity due to lack of storing area. Waiting time 1/2 days.

GREECE

Inland hauliers announced open strike as from 28/7 affecting shipments from greek ports.

HAIFA

Port is currently congested due to heavy traffic. Waiting time 1 day.

PORT SAID WEST/EAST

P.said east is congested.

Waiting time 2 days.

P.said west is congested. Waiting time 2 days.

LATTAKIA

Gantry Crane No.4 sustained serious damages and is expected to remain out of service for one-two months more.

We remind that shipment of IMO containers are subject to correct application, declaration and labeling, under booking line responsibilities. Furthermore, relevant authorization must be obtained from UFS DG Department, e-mail : hazardous@utdfeeder.com

VARIOUS

- Due to Custom Rules in Italy, we remind that all the cargo destined to Italian ports must be declared in the first port of call of the country.
- Any kind of arms, military goods or normal goods for military administrations from/to or in transit in Italian ports, must be approved by Italian police authority before loading.
- Relevant application must be done by shipper/booking line advising UFS.
